

Te Awhioraki Welfare Eligibility

“Te Awhioraki has a mission to provide a quality university experience for all Māori students of Lincoln University through representation, services and extra-curricular activities. “

Eligibility:

To apply for our Welfare funds, Taura must be enrolled at Te Whare Wānaka o Aoraki. Our fund is available to both Māori and Taura of other ethnicities, who can prove they are undergoing financial struggles and are seeking our Tautoko.

Our criteria:

- **Noho / Accommodation Costs:** Rent, housing, moving expenses
- **Hauora:** Medical Expenses, counselling, or other health-related expenses
- **Unexpected Costs:** Sudden expenses such as travel due to whānau emergencies, urgent repairs, or unforeseen personal crises.

Receipts and your account number will need to be provided to our association in order to progress with your applications.

Priority will be given to our Māori taura as well as non-Māori who frequently engage with our Kaupapa. Te Awhioraki promote inclusivity, we welcome all students who are seeking support to apply. Our Whare is always open, *Nau Mai Haere Mai*.

We try our best to process these applications as quickly as possible, however, there may be some delays, and we may require some more information from you.
